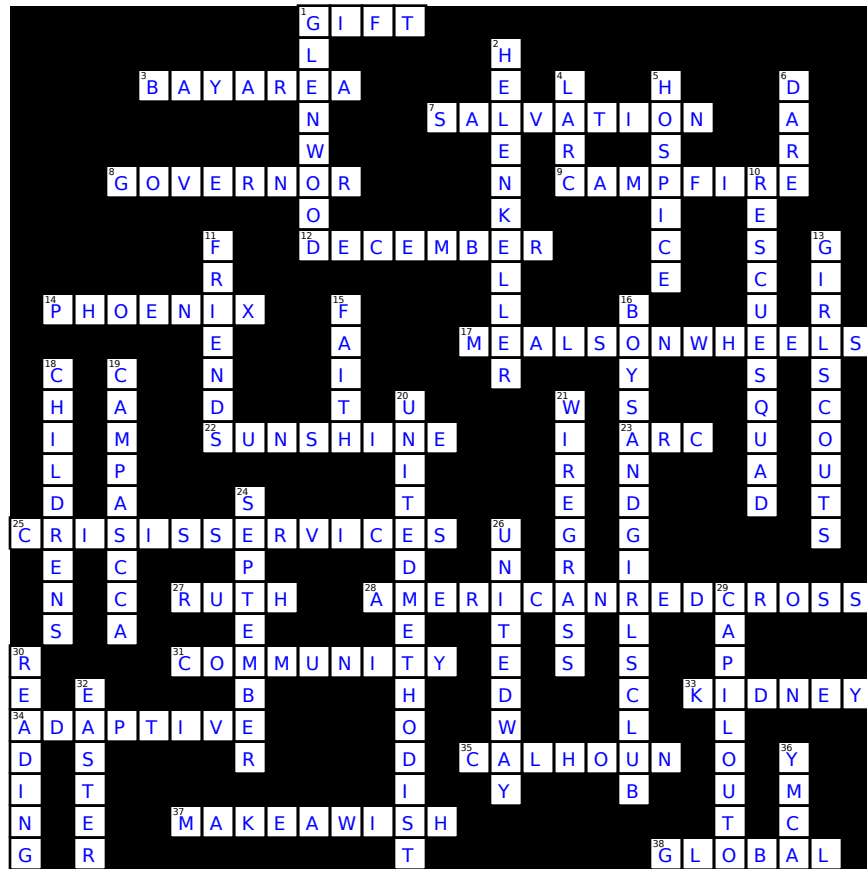


State Combined Campaign Puzzler
